# Jefferson City man charged with 2004 bank robbery

A Jefferson City man was charged Saturday for allegedly robbing Jefferson Bank, 700 Southwest Blvd., on Nov. 10, 2004.

Michael A. Jackson, 24, of 1021-A Buena Vista St., was charged with second-degree robbery. He was arrested in St. Louis for an outstanding warrant unrelated to the bank robbery.

During the robbery, a man entered the bank and displayed a note to the teller demanding money. No weapon was displayed and the subject left the bank with an undisclosed amount of money.

He reportedly fled in a gray or silver Cadillac.

Cole County prosecuting attorney Bill Tackett credits the assistance of the FBI for information leading to the capture of the suspect.

Jackson was identified by a probation/parole officer in the city from a photo from the bank robbery.
