

Man sentenced to 10 years in prison

A Jefferson City man will serve 10 years in prison for robbing two stores last October.

Cole County Judge Tom Brown recently handed down the sentence for Marcus Jackson, 21, 817 Lee.

Jackson pled guilty in April to two counts of first-degree robbery and two counts of armed criminal action. He admitted to

taking part in the robbery of Taco Bell, 2605 Missouri Blvd., and Break Time, 627 Clark Ave., about two days apart from each other.

In other recent action, Judge Brown:

- Ordered a two-year prison term for a Jefferson City man charged with possession of marijuana and methamphetamine.

West, was charged in February 2004.

Also recently, Cole County Judge Richard Callahan revoked the probation of a Jefferson City woman.

Heather Mahan, 28, 500 Mulberry No. 3, originally was charged with passing a bad check in March 2005 and was put on three years probation in December 2005.
