## Man found guilty on drug charge

A Cole County jury Tuesday found a Jefferson City man guilty of selling a controlled substance.

Jurors determined that Robert M. Hayes, 38, of 714 Maple St., sold 1.8 grams of crack cocaine on Jan. 3 to a confidential informant. The informant paid \$50 for the drug.

Hayes, who was being held in the Cole County Jail, was indicted by a grand jury as a prior offender.

The Jefferson City-Cole County Drug Task Force investigated the case.
